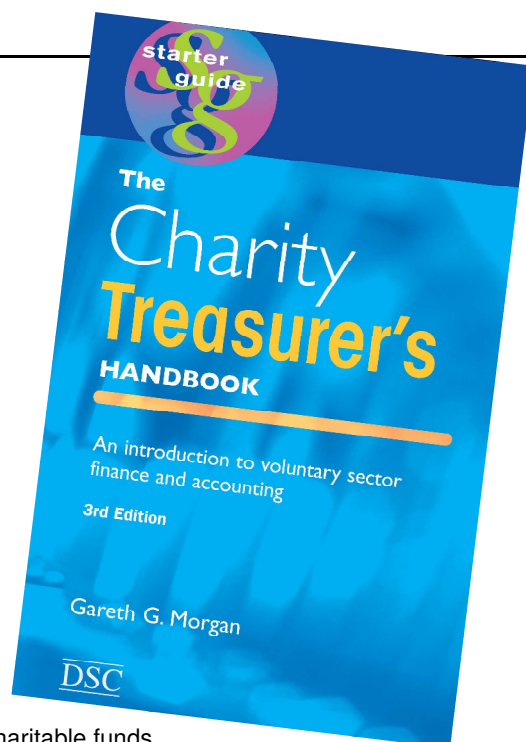

It also includes the latest accounting changes for charitable companies and the new CIO structure.
